Join us for Research Day!

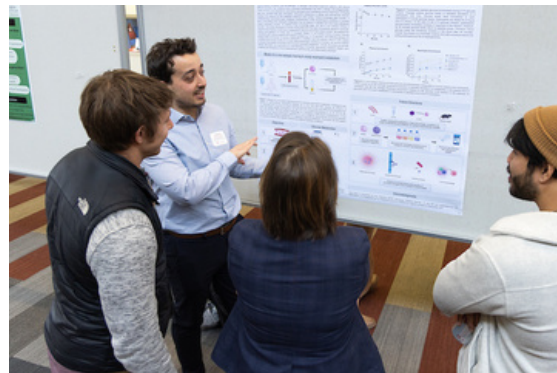
