



Summaries of UW ICTR Funded Dissemination Supplement Awards, 2014

1. Title: *Evidence-Based Tobacco Dependence Treatment Clinician Days of Learning*

Awardee: Robert Adsit, MPH. Director of Outreach, Center for Tobacco Research and Intervention, Department of Medicine, UW SMPH

Stakeholders: Statewide health professionals including physicians, nurses, physician assistants, mental health and substance use professionals, dentists, and dental hygienists.

Summary: This award supported the translation of tobacco dependence treatment research into practical, actionable resources and provided training and technical assistance to help healthcare providers and systems incorporate this research into practice via three Wisconsin regional *Days of Learning*, at which clinicians learned about the latest tobacco-dependence treatment research and how they could incorporate evidence-based methods into their practice, while providing a chance to interact and network with other clinicians and healthcare providers. The *Clinician Day of Learning* was held at three Wisconsin locations (Eau Claire, Neenah, Milwaukee) with 165 participating clinicians and health professionals.

2. Title: *Integration of the Stepping On fall prevention program into the UW Hospital and Clinics*

Awardee: Hee Soo Jung, MD. Trauma and Acute Care Surgery, Department of Surgery, UW SMPH

Stakeholders: Dane County Fall Prevention Task Force, Wisconsin Institute for Healthy Aging, UWHC, UW SMPH

Summary: Stepping On is an evidence-based intervention to reduce falls in older adults. The Stepping On curriculum has been adapted, tested, and operationalized by UW Madison researchers. This award supported the implementation of Stepping On at UW Hospital and Clinics and integrated the intervention into the UWHC Department of Specialty Nursing *Learning Center* program.

3. Title: *Using technology to improve dissemination and translation of SHOW data to public health officials and stakeholders in Wisconsin*

Awardee: Kristen Malecki, PhD, MPH. Department of Population Health Sciences, UW SMPH

Stakeholders: Wisconsin Clearinghouse for Prevention Research, Wisconsin Department of Health Regional Health Officers

Summary: This project involved a collaboration with state health partners to develop a web portal designed to disseminate key health indicators from the Survey of the Health of Wisconsin (SHOW) to provide timely data to local health departments for evaluation, targeted decision-making, and policy action to improve public health. 4. Title: *The Wisconsin Sports Concussion Education Project*

Awardee: Timothy McGuine, PhD, ATC. Sports Medicine Program, Department of Orthopedics and Rehabilitation, UW SMPH/UW Health

Stakeholders: Leaders and membership of the Wisconsin Academy of Family Physicians, the Wisconsin Athletic Trainers Association, and the Wisconsin Association of School Nurses

Summary: This award supported the development of educational materials for medical providers and school officials on how to properly recognize and treat sport concussions, and how to properly administer a variety of sport concussion assessment tools including the Sports Concussion Assessment Tool 3rd (SCAT 3). This

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project disseminated evidence-based information, including data generated at UW Madison, to medical providers across Wisconsin. Presentations were made to the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA), physician's assistant professional organizations, the National Federation of High Schools (NFHS), and UWHC nurses and staff.



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
